Lambert-St. Louis International Airport is a major airport with a small town feel. With just two terminals, it's easy to navigate. It was built in 1920 on 170 acres of farmland by Albert Lambert who learned to fly with the Wright Brothers. Lambert now encompasses 3970 acres.

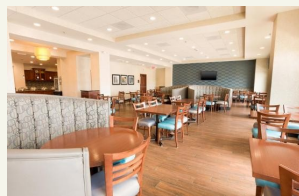

What to do in St. Louis

The Gateway Arch - Take a trip 630 feet in the air to the top of the Gateway Arch for a memorable experience you will never forget. Once your feet are firmly planted back on the ground, there's more to explore on the Gateway Arch grounds with Drury's **Gateway Arch Experience VIP Package**.



Six Flags Over Mid-America/ Hurricane Harbor - The 'coasters at Six Flags St. Louis aren't something to take lightly. With names like Ninja, Pandemonium and the Screamin' Eagle, you know you're in for some wild rides. Then head on over to Hurricane Harbor for some equally wild entertainment, but only if you are brave enough to face the Tornado, Big Kahuna and Wahoo Racer.

Botanical Gardens: This oasis in the middle of the city is one of the most charming places to visit. The garden includes a 14 acre Japanese strolling garden, the Climatron (a geodesic dome conservatory), a children's garden (including a pioneer village and playground, a fountain area and a locking system similar to the locking system at the Panama Canal). You may also visit the Gladney Rose Garden, the English Woodland Garden, the Chinese Garden, the Blanke Boxwood, the Biblical Garden and the Ottoman Garden with its water features. Stroll through the Linnean Greenhouse. Built in 1882 it is the oldest continually operated greenhouse west of the Mississippi River. Henry Shaw's original 1850 estate home graces the Botanical Garden grounds.



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Forest Park is one of St. Louis' most valuable treasures. Covering 1371 acres, the park is located in the heart of the city. Founded in 1876, it is one of the U.S. largest public parks and the home of the 1904 World's Fair. It is the home to the region's major cultural institutions—the Zoo, Art Museum, History Museum, Science Center and the Muny Opera. It also serves as a sports center for golf, tennis, baseball, bicycling, boating, fishing, handball, ice skating, roller blading, jogging, rugby and more.

Saint Louis Zoo - Watch an ape use a blade of grass as a toothpick, walk through an underwater tunnel with sea lions swimming above or experience the River's Edge for a close up look at the Zoo's elephants and rhinos. With 5000 animals from 700 species on 90 acres, plan on a day long adventure with the country's 3rd best zoo (and the world's 4th best)! And the best part: Admission to the St. Louis Zoo is always **FREE!**



The St. Louis Art Museum is one of the city's hidden gems. Ranked #25 in the nation, the Art Museum boasts an encyclopedic collection of more than 33,000 works.

Admission to the Museum is **FREE** every day. Admission to featured exhibitions is free on Friday.

The Municipal Theatre Association of St. Louis is also known as The Muny. Located in Forest Park, it is an outdoor theatre that seats 11,000 people with approximately 1,500 **free** seats in the last nine rows that are available on a first come, first served basis.

Featured Muny Performance August 10 - 16, 2015: Rodgers and Hammerstein's masterpiece *Oklahoma!* This beautiful and dramatic show features an unforgettable story and a score filled with landmark songs such as "Oh, What a Beautiful Mornin'," "The Surrey With the Fringe on Top," "People Will Say We're in Love," and of course, "Oklahoma!"

Saint Louis Science Center - As you enter the Science Center, a robotic life-sized T-Rex greets your family at the door. For some children, the exhibit increases their interest in the prehistoric area while for others, it heightens their enthusiasm to see what else there is inside to explore. Future archeologists or not, experience it all with the Drury's [Saint Louis Science Center package](#).

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The Boathouse at Forest Park: This casual restaurant, bar and boat rental facility is located in Forest Park on Post-Dispatch Lake. It is like no other place in St. Louis. In the warm weather enjoy leisurely boat rides, lakeside patio dining, cold drinks and beautiful sunsets. Weekends may find local bands playing in the evening hours. Just across the street and on the hilltop is the famous **World's Fair Pavilion**. Take a photo at the beautiful fountains at the base of the hill.



The Highlands Golf & Tennis Center: Formerly known as St. Louis Amateur Athletic Association, the newly renovated golf & tennis center is located in Forest Park. Jimmy Connors and Judy Rankin both began their careers here and St. Louis native Dwight Davis hosted several Davis Cup tournaments at this location. Book a tee-time at what is known as the [best city golf course in the Midwest](#) or tennis court at the [Dwight Davis Tennis Center](#)

Missouri History Museum: The Missouri History Museum is located in historic Forest Park and offers exhibitions and events including theatrical performances, concerts, family festivals, special events, presentations and more.
